PATENT ASSIGNMENT

THIS ASSIGNMENT, between the HECKETT MULTISERV WEST DIVISION OF HARSCO CORPORATION, a corporation organized under the laws of the state of Delaware with its principal office located at 612 N. Main Street, Butler, Pennsylvania 16003 ("HARSCO CORPORATION"), and HARSCO TECHNOLOGIES CORPORATION, a corporation organized under the laws of the state of Minnesota with its principal office located at 415 N. Main Street, Fairmount, Minnesota 56031 ("HARSCO TECHNOLOGIES").

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) in hand paid by said HARSCO TECHNOLOGIES, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, HARSCO CORPORATION has sold, assigned, transferred and set over, and by these presents does hereby sell, assign, transfer and set over, to said HARSCO TECHNOLOGIES, its entire right, title and interest in and to the Patent Properties and the inventions or improvements and applications embodying them, and also any and all continuations, divisions, renewals, extensions, reissues, reexaminations and substitutes for said Patent Properties, and in, to and under any and all Letters Patent which may be granted on or as a result thereof in the United States and its possessions and territories, the same to be held and enjoyed by said HARSCO TECHNOLOGIES, its successors, assigns, nominees or legal representatives, to the full end of the term or terms for which said Letters Patent respectively may be granted, reissued or extended, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by HARSCO CORPORATION had this assignment, sale and transfer not been made.

AND HARSCO CORPORATION covenants that it has full right to convey the entire interest herein assigned, and that it has not executed and will not execute any agreement in conflict herewith, and further covenants and agrees that it will, each time request is made and without undue delay, execute and deliver all such papers as may be necessary or desirable to perfect, confirm and record the title to said inventions or improvements, said applications and said Letters Patent in said HARSCO TECHNOLOGIES, its successors, assigns, nominees, or legal representatives, and agrees to communicate to HARSCO TECHNOLOGIES or to

its nominees all known facts respecting said inventions or improvements, said applications and said Letters Patent, to provide testimony in any legal proceedings, to sign all lawful papers, to execute all disclaimers and divisional, continuing, reissue and related applications, to make all rightful oaths, and generally to do everything possible to aid HARSCO TECHNOLOGIES, its successors, assigns, nominees and legal representatives to obtain and enforce for its own benefit proper patent protection for said inventions or improvements in the United States and its possessions and territories.

AND HARSCO CORPORATION hereby authorizes and requests the United States Patent and Trademark Office to issue or transfer to HARSCO TECHNOLOGIES the entire right, title and interest, in and to any and all Letters Patent for said inventions or improvements, which may be issued and granted on or as a result of the patents and applications aforesaid, in accordance with the terms of this Assignment.
