REQUEST FOR GARNISHMENT OF PATENTS

Pell Communications, Inc. (hereinafter "Pell"), by Leonard C. Redmond, III, its attorney, request that the United States Patent and Trademark Office allow it to garnish the royalties of Link Plus Corporation's (hereinafter "Link Plus") patents, and in support of this request states:

1. On February 25, 1997, The Honorable Alfred L. Brennan, Sr., Judge of the Circuit Court for Baltimore County, granted summary judgment in favor of Pell against Link Plus in the amount of Eighty-Four Thousand, Two Hundred Ninety-Eight Dollars and Fourteen Cents (\$84,298.14), plus interest at the rate of ten percent per annum from the date of judgment. A copy of this Order, labeled Exhibit I, is appended hereto and incorporated herein.

2. Link Plus owns two (2) patents: number 5495468, titled "System and method for transmitting plural information waveforms over a single communications channel using lincompex techniques," and number 5454010, titled "System and method for calibration of frequency hopping."

3. Link Plus has failed to make any attempts to satisfy this judgment.

WHEREFORE, Pell Communications, Inc., respectfully request that this Office grant its request to garnish the royalties of Link Plus' patents, numbers 5495468 and 5454010, until the judgment has been satisfied.


