ASSIGNMENT

THIS ASSIGNMENT, effective of May 31, 1995, made by John Haywood, Assignor, to The University of Sydney, a corporation established by Act of the Parliament of the state of New South Wales, Australia, Assignee, having a place of business at Paramatta Road, Sydney NSW 2006, Australia.

WHEREAS, Assignor has invented a new and useful invention entitled FIBRE OPTIC TRANSDUCER for which an application for Australia Patent was filed on May 31, 1995 having serial no. PN3292, an International Patent Application was filed on May 30, 1996 having serial no. PCT/AU96/00330, and an application for United States Letter Patent was executed by him this day;

WHEREAS, Assignor believes himself to be the original, first and sole inventor of the invention disclosed and claimed in said application for Letters Patent; and

WHEREAS, Assignee desires to acquire by formal, recordable assignment the entire right, title and interest in and to said invention, said application, and any Letters Patent that may be granted for said invention in the United States and throughout the world;

applications any priority rights to which such applications are entitled under international conventions, treaties or otherwise.

Further, Assignor agrees that, upon request and without further compensation, but at no expense to Assignor, it and its legal representatives and assigns will do all lawful acts, including the execution of papers and the giving of testimony, that may be necessary or desirable for obtaining, sustaining, reissuing or enforcing Letters Patent in the United States and throughout the world for said invention, and for perfecting, recording or maintaining the title of Assignee, its successors and assigns, to said invention, said application, and any Letters Patent granted for said invention in the United States and throughout the world.

Assignor represents and warrants that it has not granted and will not grant to others any rights inconsistent with the rights granted herein.

Assignor authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States and of all foreign countries to issue any Letters Patent granted for said invention, whether on said application or on any subsequently filed division, continuation, continuation-in-part or reissue application, to Assignee, its successors and assigns, as the assignee of the entire interest in said invention.
