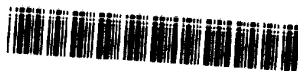





entire right, title, and interest in said patent and the invention covered thereby.

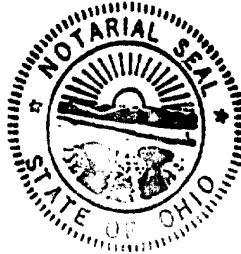

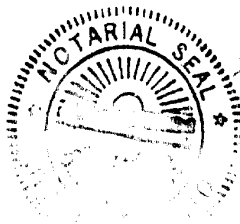

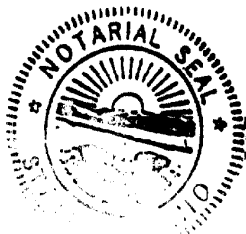
