WHEREAS, the undersigned Govindarajan Rangarajan, of Sunnyvale, California, Eugene Krivopaltsev, of San Jose, California, Sassan Shahriary, of Pleasanton, California, Joe Scarpelli, of Mountain View, California, Subodh Bapat, of Palo Alto, California, Michael Moran, of Santa Cruz, California, and Raghavendra Sondur of Santa Clara, California, hereinafter termed "Inventors", having invented new and useful improvements in A METHOD, APPARATUS & PROGRAM PRODUCT FOR INTERFACING A MULTI-THREADED, CLIENT-BASED API TO A SINGLE-THREADED, SERVER-BASED API and having made application for a U.S. Patent No. 08/957,794 filed October 24, 1997, disclosing and identifying the invention; and

extent deemed necessary or desirable by said Assignee (a) for perfecting in said Assignee the right, title and interest herein conveyed; (b) for prosecuting any of said applications; (c) for filing and prosecuting substitute, divisional, continuing or additional applications covering said invention; (d) for filing and prosecuting applications for reissuance of any said patents; (e) for interference or other priority proceedings involving said invention; and (f) for legal proceedings involving said invention and any applications therefor and any patents granted thereon, including without limitation opposition proceedings, cancellation proceedings, priority contests, public use proceedings, infringement actions and court actions; provided, however, that the expense incurred by said Inventors in providing such cooperation shall be paid for by said Assignee.
