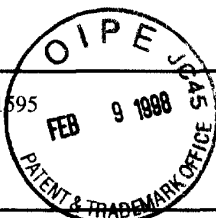

ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS we, John A. Flygare, Julio Cesar Medina, Bei Shan, David Louis Clark and Terry J. Rosen, of Burlingame, Belmont, Foster City, Albany and Burlingame, CA, respectively, have invented certain new and useful improvements, *Pentafluorobenzenesulfonamides and Analogs*, and having executed an application for United States patent disclosing and identifying the invention, said application filed on July 18, 1997 and identified by US Serial No. 08/896,280; and


