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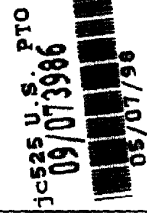

its successors, assigns, and legal representatives;


AND I HEREBY agree to transfer a like interest upon
