PATENT ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, JOHN CRANE INC., a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Delaware, having its principal place of business at 6400 West Oakton Street, Morton Grove, Illinois 60053, (hereinafter "JOHN CRANE" or "ASSIGNOR") is the owner of United States Letters Patent No. 4,363,423, entitled Diaphragm Dispenser (hereinafter "the Patent"), as well as all inventions and improvements disclosed or claimed therein; and

WHEREAS, EG&G, INC., a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, having its principal place of business located at 45 William Street, Wellesley, Massachusetts 02181 (hereinafter "EG&G" or "ASSIGNEE") is desirous of acquiring all the right, title and interest in, to and under the Patent; and

as well as all inventions and improvements disclosed or claimed therein, including, without limitation, all claims and causes of action for, and all right to sue for and to recover and retain damages for past infringements of, or unpaid royalties with respect to the use of the Patent (whether or not expired) and including, but not limited to, the right to receive any other compensation or damages with respect to the Patent, the same to be held and enjoyed by EG&G, as ASSIGNEE, its successors, assigns, designees or other legal representatives, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by the ASSIGNOR had this assignment not been made.

And for the same consideration, ASSIGNOR hereby covenants that no assignment, sale, transfer, agreement or encumbrance has been made or will be made or entered into which would conflict with this assignment and sale.

And for the same consideration, ASSIGNOR hereby further covenants to cooperate with EG&G in any action in a court or administrative proceeding in an administrative agency, and that JOHN CRANE, upon EG&G's request, will provide EG&G, as ASSIGNEE, promptly all pertinent facts and documents relating to the Patent and said inventions and improvements as may be known and accessible to ASSIGNOR, and ASSIGNOR will testify, and direct its employees to testify and otherwise cooperate with EG&G, at EG&G's expense, as to the same in any proceeding or interference in an administrative agency or action in a court of law related thereto and ASSIGNOR will promptly execute and deliver to ASSIGNEE or its legal representative any and all papers, instruments or affidavits required to apply for, obtain, maintain, issue and enforce said Patent and said inventions and improvements which may be necessary or desirable to carry out the

purposes hereof, and to transfer valid title to EG&G and to record such transfer, as requested by EG&G and to assist EG&G in perfecting said title.
