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

THIS REVOCATION OF PATENT ASSIGNMENT AND RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST is made this the 9th day of July, 1998, by FIRST UNION NATIONAL BANK (successor by merger with First Union National Bank of North Carolina), a national banking association, with offices located at 300 North Greene Street, Post Office Box 21965, Greensboro, North Carolina 27429 ("Bank");

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Highland Industries, Inc., a Delaware corporation ("Borrower"), executed in favor of the Bank a certain Patent Assignment, dated December 19, 1988, recorded on January 6, 1989, at Reel 4991, Frame 654, Office of the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks (the "Assignment"), pursuant to which the Borrower assigned to the Bank all of its right, title, and interest in and to the patents more fully described in the Assignment (the "Patents") including specifically those set forth on Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

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
