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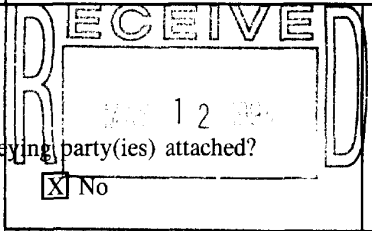

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ASSIGNMENT

FOR VALUE RECEIVED, I, DOUGLAS H. WYLIE, a citizen of Canada, residing at 2 Griffin Street, Waterdown, Ontario, Canada L0R 2H0, hereby sell, assign, transfer and convey unto BAY MILLS LIMITED, a corporation of Canada having a place of business BayForm Division, 500 Barmac Drive, Weston, Ontario, Canada M9L 2X8, its successors, assigns and legal representatives (hereinafter called the "Assignee"), the entire right, title and interest, for all countries, in and to certain inventions relating to a SCREEN AND FRAME ASSEMBLY IN WHICH THE SCREEN IS ADHESIVELY SECURED TO THE FRAME AND RELATED METHODS OF MANUFACTURING SUCH PRODUCTS, and described in an application for Letters Patent of the United States No. 08/997,737, filed on December 24, 1997, and in and to said application, and all divisions, renewals and continuations thereof, and all Letters Patent of the United States which may be granted, thereon, and all reissues and extensions thereof, and all applications for Letters Patent or other grants of protection of proprietary rights including, but not limited to, inventor's certificate, utility model, utility certificate, patent of importation, registration of patent and industrial design registration which may be filed, and which may be granted, upon said inventions in any countries or regions foreign to the United States, and all reissues, renewals and extensions thereof; and I hereby authorize and request the Assistant Commissioner of Patents of the United States, and all officials of countries or regions foreign to the United States having authority so to do, to issue all such Letters Patent or other grants of protection upon said inventions to the Assignee or to such nominees as it may designate.

AND I authorize and empower the said Assignee or nominees to invoke and claim for any application for such Letters Patent or other grants of protection for said inventions filed by it or them, the benefit of the right of priority provided by the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, as amended, or by a convention which may henceforth be substituted for it, and to invoke and claim such right of priority without further written or oral authorization from me.

AND I hereby consent that a copy of this assignment shall be deemed a full and formal equivalent of any assignment, consent to file or like document which may be required in any country or region for any purpose and more particularly in proof of the right of the said Assignee or nominees to claim the aforesaid benefit of the right of priority provided by the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, as amended, or by any convention which may henceforth be substituted for it.


AND I hereby covenant that I have the full right to convey the entire right, title and interest herein assigned and that I have not executed and will not execute any agreement in conflict herewith.
