ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Daniel R. Reneau, of Madison, Wisconsin (hereinafter "ASSIGNOR"), has invented a Roll-Over Shunt Sensor, for which application is being made for Letters Patent in the United States, said application being executed by ASSIGNOR on May 20, 1998; and
