
identified and described in a U.S. patent application filed October 20, 1997, Serial No. 08/953,924; and

I have sold, assigned, transferred and set over and, by these presents, do hereby assign, transfer and set over to said ASSIGNEE the right to sue for past infringement and retain no right to any recoveries for infringement or to sue in my own name with regard to the Patent. I hereby grant ASSIGNEE all patent rights as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by me as if the Assignment had not been made.


