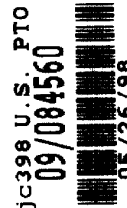

ASSIGNMENT


