ASSIGNMENT

GEMSTONE IDENTIFICATION, TRACKING AND RECOVERY SYSTEM

successors and assigns; and I do hereby agree that the said COMMAND SYSTEMS, INC., may apply for foreign Letters Patent on said invention and that I will execute all papers necessary in connection with the United States and foreign applications when called upon to do so by the said COMMAND SYSTEMS, INC., its successors or assigns, and that I will fully assist and cooperate in all matters in connection with the United States and foreign applications and patents issuing thereon.
