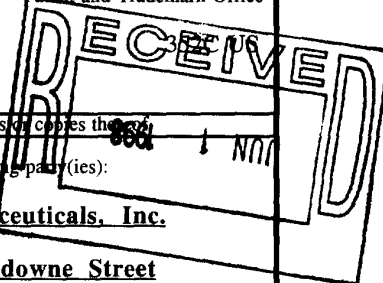

and all extensions, renewals and reissues thereof;






