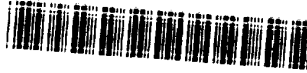

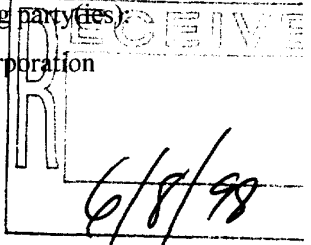

CONFIRMATORY ASSIGNMENT


For good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Stoesser Industries, Inc., a California corporation having its principal place of business at 2440 Leghorn Street, Mountain View, CA 94039 ("ASSIGNOR", herein) has assigned and does hereby assign and transfer to OLEC Corporation, a California corporation, having its principal place of business at 17112 Armstrong Avenue, Irvine, CA 92614-5718 ("ASSIGNEE", herein) the entire right, title and interest in and to the United States Letters Patent No. 5,072,257, entitled "Vacuum Frame Hinge", issued on December 10, 1991, and in and to any and all corresponding pending applications for patent and all corresponding patents issuing thereon or therefor in any and all countries, including all divisions, reissues, continuations and extensions thereof, and all rights of priority resulting from the filing in the United States of the application for said United States Letters Patent, together with the right to sue for and recover damages for past infringement of said United States and foreign patents and to stand in the place of the Assignor in all matters related thereto.

The Assignor warrants, represents, and covenants that it is the sole and exclusive owner of the inventions and United States Letters Patent, and that it has the right and authority to make this Assignment without violating the rights of other parties, that the United States Letters Patent are valid, and in full force and effect as of this Assignment thereof to the Assignee, that the United States Letters Patent are free of any liens, security interests, claims of ownership or other rights, and other encumbrances of any nature, and that there have not been granted to any other person, corporation or other entity any right, license, shop right, or other privilege regarding the inventions set forth in the United States Letters Patent.

The Assignor agrees that on request and without further consideration, but at the expense of the Assignee, the Assignor will communicate to the Assignee or its representatives or nominees any facts known to the Assignor regarding the United States Letters Patent and the inventions set forth therein, and will testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, execute all reissue applications, make all lawful oaths, cooperate and assist in the prosecution of interference proceedings involving said inventions and in the reexamination and adjudication of the United States Letters Patent, and generally do everything possible to aid the Assignee, its successors, assigns and nominees to obtain, maintain, and enforce patent protection in all countries for the inventions set forth in the United States Letters Patent identified above.

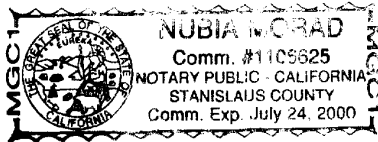
