

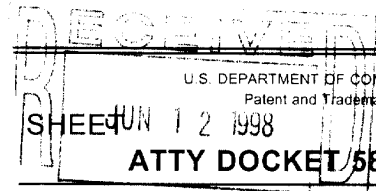

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ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, WE, George F. Majetich, and Rodgers Hicks, (herein called "ASSIGNORS"), residing at 200 Gran Ellen Drive, Athens, GA 30606, and 645 Harve Mathis Road, Athens, GA 30601 respectively, are the co-inventors of the subject matter disclosed in Provisional Patent Application "CARBODIIMIDE-PROMOTED EPOXIDATION OF OLEFINS," Serial No. 60/013,031; filed in the United States Patent Office on March 8, 1996, Greenlee, Winner and Sullivan, P.C., Attorney Docket No. 58-95P.

WHEREAS, the University of Georgia Research Foundation (herein called "ASSIGNEE"), organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia, having a principal place of business at DW Brooks Drive, Athens, GA 30602, is desirous of obtaining our entire right, title and interest in, to and under the said invention and the said application;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of our contractual or other obligations to assign said subject matter and other good and valuable consideration the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we, the said ASSIGNORS, have sold, assigned, transferred and set over, and by these presents do hereby sell, assign, transfer and set over, unto the said ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, our entire right, title and interest in, to and under the said invention, and the said Provisional United States Application and any right we may have in any United States patent applications taking priority from the said provisional application, renewals and continuations thereof, and all Patents of the United States which may be granted thereon and all reissues and extensions thereof; and all applications for industrial property protection, including, without limitation, all applications for patents, utility models, and designs which may hereafter be filed for said invention in any country or countries foreign to the United States, together with the right to file such applications and the right to claim for the same the priority of the said United States provisional application under The International Union for the Protection for Industrial Property, or any other international agreement or the domestic laws of the country in which any such application is filed, as may be applicable; and all forms of industrial property protection, including, without limitation, patents, utility models, inventors' certificates and designs which may be granted for said subject matter in any country or countries foreign to the United States and all extensions, renewals and reissues thereof;

AND WE HEREBY authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States, and any official of any country or countries foreign to the United States whose duty it is to issue patents or other evidence or forms of industrial property protection on applications as aforesaid, to issue the same to the said ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, in accordance with the terms of this instrument;

AND WE HEREBY covenant and agree that we have full right to convey the entire interest herein assigned, and that we have not executed, and will not execute, any agreement in conflict herewith;

AND WE HEREBY further covenant and agree that we will communicate to the said ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, any facts known to us respecting said subject matter, and testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, execute all divisional, continuing, reissue and foreign applications, make all rightful oaths, and generally do everything possible to aid the said ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, to obtain and enforce proper protection for said subject matter in all countries.

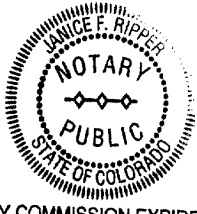
