C O N F I R M A T O R Y   A S S I G N M E N T

I, Thomas D. Van Court, residing at 99 Granite Street, Londonderry, New Hampshire 03053, hereby acknowledge and correct an error in the original Assignment of U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 08/626,171, filed on March 29, 1996, and recorded on June 3, 1996 at Reel No. 7987, Frame No. 0528. The original Assignment erroneously identified the Assignee as PixelVision, Inc. rather than PixelVision Technology, Inc. The error occurred because PixelVision, Inc., and PixelVision Technology, Inc. merged, and PixelVision Technology, Inc. is the surviving corporation of that merger. However, the patent counsel for PixelVision, Inc. and PixelVision Technology, Inc. who prepared the assignment containing the erroneous name had not been informed of the merger prior to the preparation and execution of the assignment and I, the inventor, did not notice the error when I executed the assignment.

Thus, in consideration of One Dollar and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I hereby confirm the sale and assignment to PixelVision Technology, Inc., a Delaware corporation, having an address at 43 Nagog Park, Acton, Massachusetts 01720, its successors and assigns, the entire right, title and interest, including the right to claim priority under the International Convention, throughout the United States, its territories and all foreign countries in and to my invention in VIDEO SIGNAL INTERFACE SYSTEM UTILIZING DEDUCTIVE CONTROL and U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 08/626,171 therefor, filed on March 29, 1996, and such patents as may issue thereon and all divisions, reissues and continuations thereof.

And I hereby covenant that I have full right to make such assignment, and agree for myself and my executors and administrators that I will, at the expense of said PixelVision Technology, Inc., execute all applications for patents in foreign countries, execute all divisional, continuing, reissue and re-examination applications, make all rightful oaths, sign all lawful papers, testify in any proceeding in which said invention or any application or patent directed thereto may be involved, and generally do everything possible to aid said PixelVision Technology, Inc., its successors and assigns, to obtain and enforce proper patent protection for said invention in the United States, its territories and all foreign countries.
