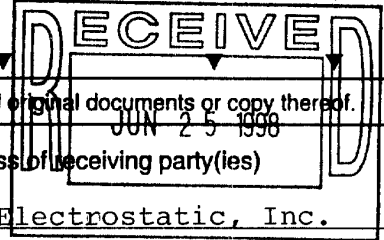

ASSIGNMENT


