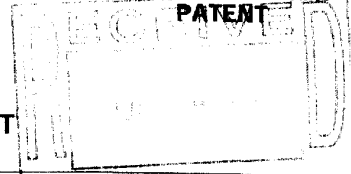



### **PATENTS ASSIGNMENT**

WHEREAS, TGTBT, Ltd., a California limited partnership, together with its successors and assigns (the "Assignor") has the sole and exclusive rights, title and interests in the patents listed on **Schedule A** attached hereto filed with the United States Patent and Trademark Office on the dates set forth therein and in the inventions set forth therein (collectively, with such inventions, the "Patents").

WHEREAS, Assignor has agreed to assign all its legal and beneficial interest in the Patents to Lousie's Settlement Company, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company (the "Assignee")

NOW, THEREFORE, for good consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which Assignor hereby acknowledges, the Assignor hereby, without reservation, irrevocably:

1. Assigns, transfers and conveys its entire right, title and interest in the Patents, any and all other applications for letters patent on the invention and discoveries therein in whatsoever countries, including, without limitation, all divisional, renewal, substitute, continuation, continuation-in-part, convention and international applications based in all or in part upon said Patents or upon said applications, any and all letters patent, reissues, reexaminations, and extensions of letters patent granted for said inventions and discoveries or predicated upon or arising from said inventions and discoveries, said applications and said letters patent, all income, royalties, damages and payments now and later due and/or payable to Assignor, including without limitation, damages and payments for past, present and future infringements, the right to sue for past, present and future infringements;

2. Authorizes Assignee to file patent applications in any and all countries on any or all of said inventions and discoveries in the name of Assignee, and to pursue any patent applications filed in the name of Assignor or applications filed in the name of any other party and assigned to Assignor in any and all countries on any or all of said inventions and discoveries, or otherwise as Assignee may deem advisable under the Patent Cooperation Treaty or otherwise;

3. Authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States of America and the empowered officials of all other governments to issue or transfer all said letters patent and applications therefore to Assignee, as assignee of the entire right, title and interest therein or otherwise as Assignee may direct;

4. Warrants that it has not conveyed to others any rights and inventions, applications or patents or any license to use the same or to make, use or sell anything embodying or utilizing any said inventions or discoveries; has good right to assign the same to Assignee without encumbrance;

5. Binds its successors and assigns, as well as itself, to do, upon Assignee's requests, but without additional consideration to Assignor, its successors or assigns, all

acts reasonably serving to ensure that said inventions and discoveries, said patent applications and said letters of patent shall be held and enjoyed by Assignee as fully and entirely as same could have been held and enjoyed by Assignor, its successors and assigns, if this assignment had not been made; and particularly to execute and deliver to Assignee all lawful application documents, including petitions, specifications and oaths, and all assignments, disclaimers, and lawful affidavits in form and substance may be requested by Assignee; to communicate to Assignee all facts known to Assignor relating to said inventions or the history thereof, and to furnish Assignee with any and all documents, photographs, models, samples and other physical exhibits in control of the Assignors, their successors or assigns, which may be useful for establishing the facts of conceptions, disclosures, and reduction of practice of said invention; and to cooperate with and assist Assignee in protecting the rights granted hereby against infringement.
