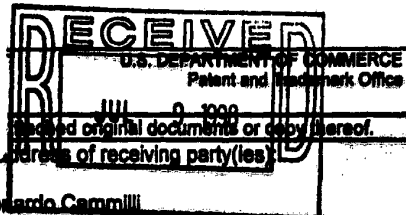

ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, We, Leonardo Cammilli, of Via Caselli 11, I-50131 (Firenze) Italy and Gino Grassi, of Via Pasqui 31, I-50019 Sesto Fiorentino (Firenze) Italy, have invented certain new and useful improvements in AN IMPLANTABLE ELECTRIC HEART DEFIBRILLATION SYSTEM WITH ATTENUATION OF THE PAIN RESULTING FROM THE ELECTRIC SHOCK for which an application for Letters Patent of the United States has been made, said application being identified in the United States Patent and Trademark Office by Serial Number 09/057,206, filed April 8, 1998; and

WHEREAS, We, Leonardo Cammilli, of Via Caselli 11, I-50131 (Firenze) Italy; Gino Grassi, of Via Pasqui 31, I-50019 Sesto Fiorentino (Firenze) Italy; and Massimo Fossi, of Piazza Garibaldi 20, I-50014 Fiesole (Firenze) Italy, (hereinafter referred to as "Assignees"), are desirous of acquiring the entire right, title and interest in and to said invention, said application and in, to and under any and all Letters Patent to be obtained therefore;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration to me in hand paid by said Assignees, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we have sold, assigned and transferred, and by these presents do hereby sell, assign and transfer unto said Assignees, their successors and assigns (in the following proportions: Leonardo Cammilli - 55%; Gino Grassi - 33%; and Massimo Fossi - 12%), our entire right, title and interest in and to said invention, said application and the Letters Patent, both foreign and domestic, that may or shall issue, including any continuation, division, renewal, or substitute thereof, and as to Letters Patent, any reissue or re-examination thereof, further including all of our entire rights under the International Convention, and we do hereby authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents to issue said Letters Patent to the above mentioned Assignees in accordance herewith.

We hereby Authorize the above mentioned Assignees, their successors and assigns, or anyone they may properly designate, to insert in this instrument the serial number and filing date of said United States application and/or otherwise take advantage of the provisions of the International Convention.

Upon Said Consideration, we do hereby covenant and agree with the Assignees, their successors and assigns, that we will not execute any writing or do any act whatsoever conflicting with these presents, and that we or our executors or administrators will at any time upon request, without further consideration, but at the expense of the Assignees, their successors or assigns, execute such additional writings and do such additional acts as the Assignees, their successors or assigns, may deem necessary or desirable to perfect the Assignees' enjoyment of this grant, and render all necessary assistance in making application for and obtaining original, continuation, divisional, reissued, re-examined or extended Letters Patent of the United States, or of any and all

foreign countries on said invention, and in enforcing any rights occurring as a result of such applications or patents, by giving testimony in any proceedings or transactions involving such applications or patents.
