ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Marc P. Kelemen residing at 31230 Hilliard Boulevard, Westlake Ohio 44145 and Susan L. Svec residing at 6873 Stearns Road, Olmsted Township, Ohio 44138, respectively (hereinafter referred to as Assignor), have invented certain new and useful improvements in ELECTROCHEMICAL CELL FORMED WITH BIG MOUTH OPEN END CAN for which an application for United States Letters Patent was executed on May 12, 1998.
