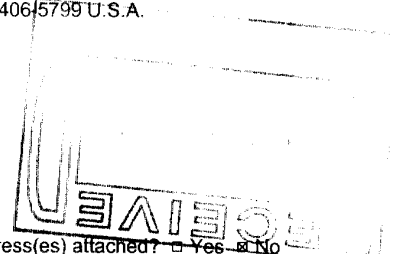

WHEREAS, Pronounced Technologies LLC, a California limited liability company, with its principal place of business at 6611 Odessa Avenue, Van Nuys, California ("Assignee") is desirous of acquiring the entire and exclusive rights, title and interest in and to the Patents and application listed above, to any Patent that may issue with respect to the invention described in application number 08/110,503, and to the underlying inventions described in the Patents and application, in the United States and throughout the world.

NOW THEREFORE, effective Sept 10th, 1998, in consideration of the sum of one dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by Assignor, Assignor hereby assigns, transfers and conveys to Assignee and Assignee's successors and assigns all of Assignor's right title and interest throughout the world in and to the Patents and the application, and the underlying inventions described therein and all future improvements thereon, and any and all Letters Patent (whether U.S. or foreign) that are or may be granted therefrom, including, without limitation, any extensions, continuations, continuations-in-part, divisions, reissues and renewals thereof, or other equivalents thereof, and further, all rights and privileges pertaining to the Patents and any Letters Patent that may issue from the application or the underlying invention described in the Patents or the application (including any continuations, continuations-in-part, divisions, reissues, and renewals thereof,) including, without limitation, right, if any, to sue or bring other actions for past, present and future infringement thereof, and to collect all damages, royalties or other fees resulting from past, present and future infringement thereof.

Assignor further assigns to and empowers Assignee, its successors, assigns or nominee, all rights to make applications for patents or other forms of protection for the aforementioned inventions and to prosecute such applications as well as to claim and receive the benefit of the right of priority provided by the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, as amended, or by any convention which may henceforth be substituted for it, and the right to invoke and claim such

right of priority without further written or oral authorization.

Assignor further agrees that Assignor will, without charge to Assignee, but at Assignee's expense: (a) cooperate with Assignee in the prosecution of U.S. patent applications and foreign counterparts on the aforementioned inventions and any improvements; (b) execute, verify, acknowledge and deliver all such further papers, including patent applications and instruments of transfer; (c) perform such other acts as Assignee lawfully may request to obtain or maintain Letters patent for the aforementioned inventions and improvements in any and all countries, and to vest title thereto in Assignee, or Assignee's successors and assigns; and (d) perform such other acts as Assignee lawfully may request in connection with any interference or infringement proceeding, and cooperate in every way possible in obtaining evidence and going forward with any such proceeding.

Assignor hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents to issue any and all Letters Patent of the United States resulting from the Application, or any continuations, continuations-in-part, divisions, reissues and renewals thereof, to Assignee, as Assignee of the entire interest therein, and hereby covenants that it has full right to convey the entire interest herein assigned, as evidenced in an Assignment of Right recorded on September 26, 1997 at Reel 8715, Frame 268; and that it has not executed and will not execute, any agreement in conflict herewith.

Assignor hereby grants Stephen R. Mick, Reg. No. 37,190 and/or William H. Wright, Reg. No. 36,312 the power to insert on this assignment any further identification which may be necessary or desirable in order to comply with the rules of the United States Patent & Trademark Office for recordation of this document.

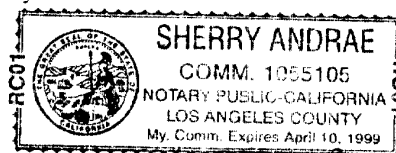
