

and Patent Applications by any third party. The foregoing conveyance specifically includes without limitation the right to sue for past infringements occurring prior to the date hereof.

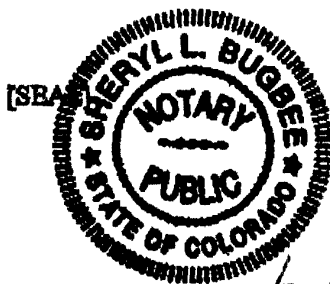
