ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, we, Ronald Perry, Norman P. Jouppi, Joel J. McCormack, and Keith Istvan Farkas have made certain inventions or discoveries (or both) set forth in an Application for Letters Patent of the United States of America entitled "Improved Techniques for Anisotropic Texture Mapping Using Multiple Space-Invariant Filtering Operations Per Pixel", the specification of which was executed by us on the date(s) indicated below;

4. 5. 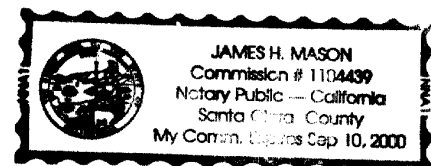

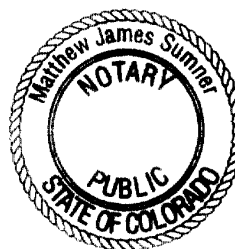
