ASSIGNMENT

Whereas, I,

Thomas P. Webber, 221 South Main Street, Box 234, Petersham, MA 01366,

have made certain inventions or discoveries (or both) set forth in an application for Letters Patent of the United States of America entitled "System And Method For Managing Buffers Using Free Pointer FIFO's Containing Pointers To Empty Buffers," which application was filed on June 30, 1998, as U.S. Application Serial No. 09/108,918;

2. Authorize Assignee to file patent applications in any or all countries on any or all of said inventions and discoveries in my name or in the name of Assignee or otherwise as Assignee may deem advisable, under the International Convention or otherwise;

3. Authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States of America and the empowered officials of all other governments to issue or transfer all said Letters Patent to Assignee, as assignee of the entire right, title and interest therein or otherwise as Assignee may direct;

4. Warrant that I have not knowingly conveyed to others any right in said inventions, discoveries, applications or patents or any license to use the same or to make, use or sell anything embodying or utilizing any of said inventions or discoveries; and that I have good right to assign the same to Assignee without encumbrance;

5. Bind my heirs, legal representatives and assigns, as well as ourselves, to do, upon Assignee's request and at Assignee's expense, but without additional consideration to me or them,
