2. Authorize Assignee to file patent applications in any or all countries or groups of countries on any or all of said inventions and discoveries in our names or in the name of said inventions and discoveries in our names and in the name of Assignee or otherwise as Assignee or otherwise as Assignee may deem advisable, under the International Convention or any other relevant convention or treaty or otherwise;

3. Authorize and request the Assistant Commissioner for Patents of the United States of American and the empowered official of all other governments to issue or

transfer all said patents to Assignee, as Assignee of the entire reight, title and interest therein or otherwise as Assignee may direct; and

4. Warrant that we have not knowingly conveyed to others any rights in said inventions, discoveries, applications or patents or any license to use the same or to make, use or sell anything embodying or utilizing any of said patents invention or discoveries; and that we have good right to assign the same to Assignee without encumbrance.
