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

RECITALS

WHEREAS, LAWRENCE R. GREEN and JOHN W. BLASECKI are the inventors of the invention described and set forth in the below-identified U.S. Patent Application for United States Letters Patent:

Title of the Invention: **Pharmaceutical Angiostatic Dipeptide Compositions and Methods of Use Thereof**

WHEREAS, LAWRENCE R. GREEN and JOHN W. BLASECKI each assigned to CYTOVEN J.V., on May 6, 1996 and May 13, 1996, respectively, all right, title, and interest in and to the above-identified invention and application and to all foreign counterparts (including patent, utility model and industrial designs), and in and to any Letters Patent and Registrations which were subsequently granted on the same in the United States and all countries throughout the world, and to claim the priority from the application as provided by the Paris Convention.

WHEREAS, by said assignment, CYTOVEN J.V. (whose sole joint venture partners at that time were CYTRAN, INC. and KMC, INC., both Washington corporations) acquired all right, title, and interest in and to the above-identified invention and application and to all foreign counterparts (including patent, utility model and industrial designs), and in and to any Letters Patent and Registrations which were subsequently granted on the same in the United States and all countries throughout the world, and to claim the priority from the application as provided by the Paris Convention.

WHEREAS, on December 31, 1996, KMC, INC. sold its interest in the joint

venture, including its share of the assets held by the joint venture, to CYTRAN, INC. for good and valuable consideration. This sale acted under Washington Corporation Law to dissolve the general partnership of CYTOVEN J.V. (RCW § 25.04.310(3)). As indicated in a purchase agreement, the intent of the parties was to transfer all assets of CYTOVEN to CYTRAN, INC.

WHEREAS, on January 16, 1998, CYTOVEN J.V. assigned to CYTRAN, INC. all right, title, and interest in and to the above-identified U.S. Patent Application and to any Letters Patent and Registrations which may be granted on said U.S. Patent Application in the United States.

WHEREAS, to wind up its affairs, CYTOVEN J.V. seeks to re-assign to LAWRENCE R. GREEN and JOHN W. BLASECKI all right, title, and interest in and to all foreign counterparts of the above-identified invention and application and in and to any foreign patents and registrations which may hereafter be granted on the same in any country or area throughout the world other than in the United States. Authority for the partnership to act in winding up its affairs after dissolution of the partnership is found in RCW § 25.04.300.

AGREEMENT

CYTOVEN J.V. hereby assigns to LAWRENCE R. GREEN and JOHN W. BLASECKI all right, title, and interest in and to all foreign counterparts of the above-identified invention and application (including foreign patent, utility model and industrial designs), and in and to all foreign patents or foreign registrations which may hereafter be granted on the same in any country or area throughout the world other than in the United States, and to claim the priority from the above-identified application for all said foreign counterparts, foreign patents, and foreign registrations as provided by the Paris Convention. Said right, title and interest is to be held and enjoyed by LAWRENCE R. GREEN and JOHN W. BLASECKI and their successors and assigns as fully and exclusively as it would have been held and enjoyed by CYTOVEN J.V. had this assignment not been made, for the full term of any foreign patents and foreign registrations which may be granted thereon, or of any division, renewal, continuation in whole or in part, substitution, conversion, reissue, prolongation or extension thereof. CYTOVEN J.V. does not assign any right, title, or interest in and to any U.S. Letters Patent or U.S. Registration which may be granted on the above-identified application in the United States.
