ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, I, **Jean-Jacques Duruz**, residing at 4, rue de Hesse, 1204, Geneva, Switzerland, (hereinafter referred to as "ASSIGNOR"), jointly with Jainagesh A. Sekhar residing c/o University of Cincinnati, Cincinnati, Ohio 45221, USA, and James Jenq Liu, have made an invention entitled **Stable Anodes For Aluminium Production Cells**, filed as US Application No. 08/817,246 on April 11, 1997 (Case Ref.
