ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, we, Subhasish Sircar and Rajeev G. Kamat hereinafter referred to as Assignors, have invented certain new and useful improvements in METHODS OF IMPROVING HOT WORKING PRODUCTIVITY AND CORROSION RESISTANCE IN AA7000 SERIES ALUMINUM ALLOYS AND PRODUCTS THEREFROM (Docket No. 08383) and have executed an application for United States Letters Patent, on even date herewith; and




