6 applications and Letters Patent.

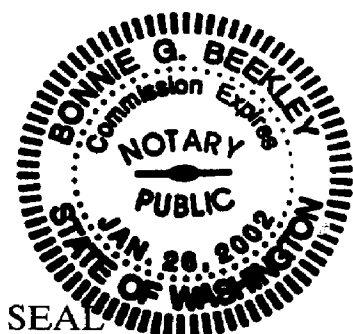


