## ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, WE, Kelly Bruland, William M. Dougherty, Joseph L. 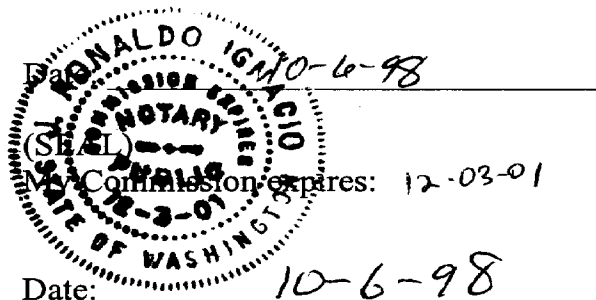
