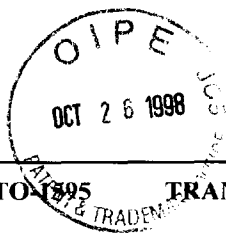

# **ASSIGNMENT OF FULL TITLE TO PATENTS, PATENT APPLICATIONS, AND INVENTIONS**

WHEREAS, CLARK EQUIPMENT COMPANY, a corporation of the State of Delaware, having a place of business at 100 North Michigan Street, South Bend, Indiana 46634 (hereinafter "ASSIGNOR") owns certain inventions and improvements disclosed in applications for Letters Patent, and has obtained Letters Patent of the United States and in foreign countries, and has applications pending in the United States and in foreign countries, said patents and applications listed in Exhibits A and B to this Assignment; and

WHEREAS, AGCO Corporation, a corporation of the State of Delaware, having a place of business at 4205 River Green Parkway, Duluth, Georgia 30136 (hereinafter, "ASSIGNEE") is desirous of acquiring all right, title, and interest in the same;

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the ASSIGNOR does sell, assign and transfer unto the ASSIGNEE its entire right, title, and interest in and to the U.S. patents and applications aforesaid and listed in Exhibit A, and in and to all inventions and improvements disclosed and described in said patents and applications, and to any continuation, continuation-in-part, divisional, reexamination, reissue and other applications relating thereto, including all rights the ASSIGNOR may have to sue for damages and other remedies in respect of any infringement of patents which may have occurred before the date of this assignment; the same to be held and enjoyed by the ASSIGNEE, for its own use and benefit, and for its legal representatives and assigns, to the full end of the term for which said Letters Patent is granted, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by the ASSIGNOR had this assignment and sale not been made;

AND for the same consideration, the ASSIGNOR does sell, assign, and transfer to the ASSIGNEE its full, exclusive, and entire right, title and interest in and to the foreign patents and applications listed in Exhibit B and any foreign patents or applications not listed in Exhibit B

but which correspond to the U.S. patents or applications listed in Exhibit A, in whole or in part, in and to any patents and similar protective rights granted on said foreign applications, and in and to the right to claim any applicable priority rights arising from or required for said foreign applications under the terms of any applicable conventions, treaties, statutes, or regulations; said foreign applications to be filed and issued in the name of the ASSIGNEE or its designee insofar as permitted by applicable law;


