ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, I, David Luetkemeyer, a citizen of the United States, resident of the City of St. Louis, State of Missouri, whose post office address is 833 Windmill Drive, St. Louis, Missouri 63011 have invented certain improvements in CLEAN AIR SYSTEM for which I have made application for Letters Patent of the United States, identified as Serial No. 08/916,661, filed August 22, 1997.


AND, WHEREAS, David Luetkemeyer and C. AND I DO HEREBY authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks to issue that said Letters Patent, when granted, to the said CUSTOM CLEANROOM CONCEPTS, its successors and assigns, as assignees of the entire right, title and interest in and to said improvements, for the sole use and behoof of said CUSTOM CLEANROOM CONCEPTS, and for its successors and assigns, to the full ends of the terms for which Letters Patent may be granted.

AND I further grant to CUSTOM CLEANROOM CONCEPTS, its successors and assigns, the right to claim for any application for patent for said improvements the full benefit of any international agreement between the United States and any foreign country or countries.
