ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, We, Irvan Pazdernik and Jeff Lenarz, declare that we are citizens of the United States of America and residents of Alexandria and Garfield, Minnesota, respectively, have invented certain new and useful improvements in Loading Apparatus for Packaging System and Method of Operating the Same for which application has been made for Letters Patent of the United States of America, the application may be identified in the United States Patent and Trademark Office by Serial No. 09/148,337 filed September 4, 1998; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing premises, and intending to be legally bound thereby, and in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, we, jointly and severally, do hereby sell, assign, and transfer unto the assignee, its successors or assigns, the entire right, title, and interest possessed by us in and to the invention, the application, and the Letters Patent, both foreign and domestic, that may or shall be granted thereon, including any original, continuation, continuation-in-part, divisional, reissued, or extended applications for Letters Patent, Letters Patents, petty patents, utility models, or utility model conversions issuing thereon, both foreign and domestic, and including all of our rights under International Convention, with all our rights, both foreign and domestic, to be held and enjoyed by the assignee for its own use and enjoyment and for the use and enjoyment of its successors and assigns to the full end of the term or terms for which such Letters Patent may be granted, as fully and entirely as would have been held and enjoyed by us had this assignment, transfer, and sale not been made.

We, jointly and severally, further authorize the assignee, its successors and assigns, or anyone it may properly designate, to apply for Letters Patent, in its own name if desired, in any and all foreign countries, and additionally to claim the filing date of the United States application or otherwise take advantage of any International Convention.


Also for the above consideration, we, jointly and severally, agree with the assignee, its successors and assigns, that we have not executed and will not execute any writings or do any act whatsoever conflicting with this Assignment, and that we will at any time upon request, without further or additional consideration, but at the expense of the assignee, its successors or assigns, promptly provide the assignee with all pertinent facts and documents relating to the invention therein disclosed, execute such additional writings and do such other lawful acts as the assignee, its successors or assigns, may deem necessary or desirable to perfect the assignee's enjoyment of this grant, and render all necessary assistance in making application for and obtaining original, continuation, continuation-in-part, divisional, reissued, or extended applications for Letters Patent, Letters Patent, petty patents, utility models, or utility model conversions of the United States of America or any foreign countries on the invention, and aid in enforcing any rights occurring as a result of such applications or patents by communicating to the assignee or its designates such facts relating to the invention and Letters Patent or the history thereof as may be known to us and by giving testimony in any proceeding, transaction, or litigation involving such applications or patents.

We hereby request the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks to issue the Letters Patent to the assignee in accordance herewith, for the sole use and enjoyment of the Assignee or its designee, its successors or assigns.
