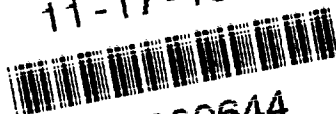

EXPANDABLE MULTIPLE FREQUENCY PROGRAMMABLE TRANSMITTER


which is set forth in an application for Letters Patent in the United States executed on even date herewith;
