ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, JOHN S. KREITZBERG, residing at 3590 NE Hancock, Portland, Oregon 97212, ("ASSIGNOR"); has invented certain new and useful improvements in an IMPROVED LOCKING PIN FOR EXCAVATING EQUIPMENT, U.S. Serial No. 08/993, 173, filed December 18, 1997;

ASSIGNOR hereby warrant to have the full right to convey the entire right, title and interest in and to said invention to ESCO and that no other instrument or assignment has been or will be executed in conflict with this Assignment.

ASSIGNOR hereby authorize and request the patent office officials in the United States and in all foreign countries to issue all of said Letters Patent to ESCO as the owner of the entire right, title and interest in and to the same;

ASSIGNOR further agree to communicate to ESCO any facts known to ASSIGNOR respecting said invention, and to testify in any legal proceeding, to sign all lawful papers, to execute all divisional, continuation, continuation-in-part, substitution, renewal, reexamination, and reissue applications, to executed all assignment papers to cause all of said Letters Patent to be issued to ESCO, to make all rightful oaths and generally do everything possible to aid ESCO, its successors and assigns, to obtain and enforce proper protection for said invention in the United States and in all foreign countries.
