The Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks is requested to issue any Patent which may be granted for said invention or any part thereof unto said corporation in keeping with this Assignment.



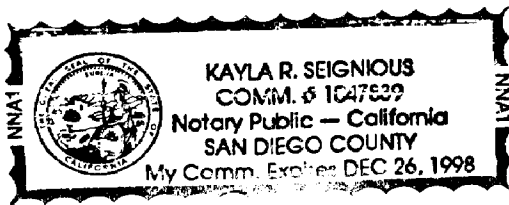
