WHEREAS, I am the sole inventor of certain new and useful improvements in PORTABLE RADIOTELEPHONES INCLUDING PATCH ANTENNAS for which an application for United States Letters Patent has been executed by me concurrently herewith, and

relating to said invention, to testify in any interference or legal proceedings involving said invention, to execute any additional papers which may be requested to confirm the right of the assignee, its representatives, successors or assigns to secure patent or similar protection for the said invention in all countries and to vest in the assignee complete title to the said invention and Letters Patent, without further compensation, but at the expense of said assignee, its successors, assigns, and other legal representatives.
