WHEREAS, STEVEN M. TIPTON, citizen of the United States, residing at 8801 South 65th East Place, Tulsa, Oklahoma 74133; MATT HACKWORTH, citizen of the United States, residing at 1940 South College Avenue,, Tulsa, Oklahoma 74104 and KELLY WILLSON, citizen of the United States, residing at 1940 South College Avenue, Tulsa, Oklahoma 74104, (hereinafter called ASSIGNORS), have invented certain new and useful improvements in a/an **VERTICAL JUMP MEASURING DEVICE**, which they are about to make application for Letters Patent of the United States, the said application having been executed on even day herewith;

countries which may be granted therefor, and any and all reissues or certificates of reexamination of said Letters Patent, including the subject matter of any and all claims which may be obtained in every such patent, the same to be held and enjoyed by the said ASSIGNEE for its own use and behoof, and for the use and behoof of its successors, assigns, or other legal representatives, to the end of the term or terms for which said Letters Patent of the United States, territories and foreign countries are or may be granted, reissued, or reexamined as fully and entirely as same would have been held and enjoyed by ASSIGNOR, if this assignment and sale had not been made.

without further compensation, but at the expense of said ASSIGNEE, its successors or other legal representatives.


