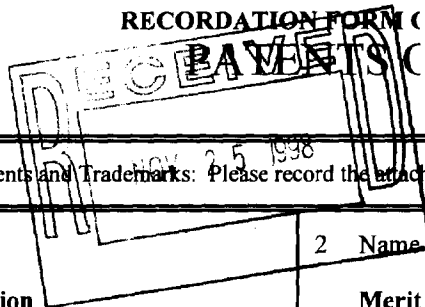

RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST  
(PATENT)


NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing premises and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged:


