# ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS by virtue of an Assignment recorded in the United States Patent and Trademark Office on Reel 9331, Frame 0292, on July 14, 1998, BRIGHT LAB. CO., LTD. (hereinafter referred to as Assignor) is the owner of United States Patent Application Serial No. 09/115 018, filed on July 14, 1998, in the name of Masaya OKITA and entitled METHOD FOR DRIVING A NEMATIC LIQUID CRYSTAL.

Further, Assignor agrees that it will communicate to said Assignee or their representatives any facts known to it respecting said invention, and testify in any legal proceedings, sign all lawful papers, execute all divisional, continuation, substitution, renewal and reissue applications, execute all necessary Assignment papers to cause any and all of said Letters Patent to be issued to said Assignee, make all rightful oaths or declarations, and generally cooperate with said Assignee, its successors and assigns, to obtain and enforce proper protection for said invention in the United States and in any and all foreign countries.
