b) The Assignor has agreed that the invention and the aforesaid Application should be transferred to the Assignee.



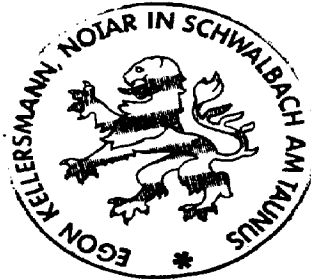


