

ASSIGNMENT

Inventions in the name of Assignor or in the name of Assignee, including the right to claim Assignor's priority rights under
any applicable international treaty or convention; all patent applications based and/or related to the Inventions; all
continuation, continuing (CPA), continuation-in-part (CIP), divisional, renewal, substitute and reissue applications based
upon the Inventions, applications and/or patents that have been filed and/or may hereafter be filed, both foreign and domestic;
all issued and subsequently issued patents or similar legal protection, both domestic and foreign, for the Inventions or related
to the Inventions in the United States of America and in all foreign countries, for the full term or terms for which the same
is and/or may be granted; the same to be held and enjoyed by Assignee for the exclusive use and benefit of Assignee as full
and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by Assignor had this sale, assignment and transfer not been made.

Assignor states, covenants, warrants and guarantees that no other assignment, license, sale, agreement or
encumbrance has been or will be made or entered into by Assignor which would conflict with this Assignment.

Assignor agrees to: promptly provide Assignee with all pertinent facts and documents relating to the Inventions,
applications, patents and other legal protection related to the Inventions, both domestic and foreign, as may be known and
accessible to Assignor; testify as to such facts and documents in any interference, opposition and/or litigation related the
Inventions; and promptly execute and deliver to Assignee or to its legal representative any and all papers, instruments and
affidavits required to apply for, obtain, maintain, issue and/or enforce the rights granted by this Assignment.

Assignor agrees and promises to execute all instruments and render all such assistance as Assignee may request
in order to: confirm Assignee has exclusive legal title to the Inventions, and to all patent applications and patents based upon
and/or related to the Inventions; file and prosecute any and all patent applications based upon and/or related to the Inventions;
and/or enforce any and/or all patents related to the Inventions, all without additional charge or expense to Assignee.

Assignor authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks to issue to Assignee all
subsequently granted patents of the United States of America that are based upon the Inventions.

This Agreement is binding upon the parties hereto, and upon their agents, heirs, successors, executors, trustees and
assigns.
