ASSIGNMENT OF PATENT RIGHTS

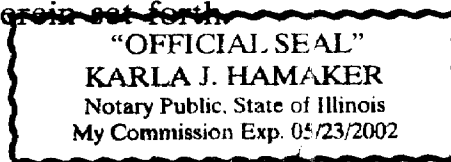
