convention, treaty and/or agreement.

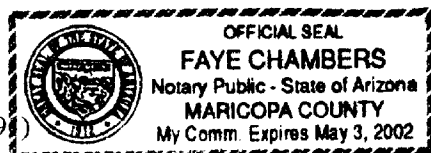
