ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Vigortech, Inc., a corporation of the State of Nebraska (hereinafter referred to as ASSIGNOR) owns all right, title and interest in new and useful improvements in SOLID MATRIX CONDITIONING OF SEEDS FOR SORTING PURPOSES as shown by the records at the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office as Reel 8847 Frame 0987 and for which United States patent application 08/979,074 was filed:

AND WHEREAS Kamterter II, LLC (hereinafter referred to as ASSIGNEE) is desirous of acquiring certain undivided rights in such patent rights:

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the payment of One Dollar and other good and valuable consideration the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged, ASSIGNOR assigns to ASSIGNEE an undivided interest in U.S. patent application 08/979,074 including all continuations-divisions, continuations-in-part, reissues and reexaminations thereof in the United States and including foreign patents issued and foreign patents which may issue from current or future applications in countries foreign to the United States creating an ownership of a different interest in U.S. patent

application 08/979,074 by each of ASSIGNOR and ASSIGNEE as follows:

(a) As a result of the transfer of the undivided interest to ASSIGNEE, ASSIGNOR shall have the exclusive right to practice under U.S. Patents with field corn, soybeans, cotton, wheat, rice, canola and salicornia;

(b) As a result of the transfer of the undivided interest to ASSIGNEE, ASSIGNEE shall have the exclusive right to practice under U.S. Patents with seeds except field corn, soybeans, cotton, wheat, rice, canola and salicornia.

AND ASSIGNOR hereby covenants and agrees that ASSIGNOR will at any time upon the request and at the expense of ASSIGNEE execute and deliver any and all papers and to do all lawful acts that may be necessary or desirable to perfect the title to said undivided interest of ASSIGNOR.

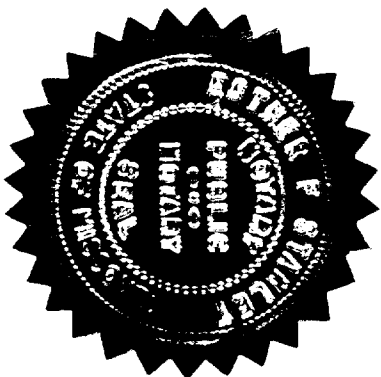

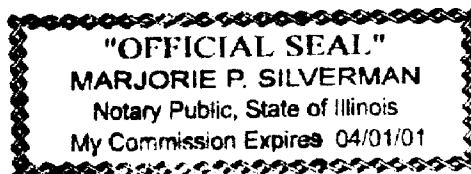
