

WHEREAS, We, John D. Bruhnke and John G. Lever, citizens of the United States of America, residing respectively at 125 Hillbrook Drive, Spartnburg, SC 29307, County of Spartanburg, State of South Carolina and 185 Edgecombe Road, Spartanburg, SC 29307, County of Spartanburg, State of South Carolina, have invented certain new and useful improvements in ANTIREFLECTIVE COATINGS COMPRISING POLY(OXYALKYLENE) COLORANTS for which we have executed an application for Letters Patent of the United States of even date herewith; and

AND WE HEREBY covenant that we have full right to convey the entire interest herein assigned, and that we have not executed, and will not execute, any agreement in conflict herewith.

AND WE HEREBY further covenant that we will communicate to the said Company, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, any facts known to us respecting said improvements, and testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, execute all divisional, continuing and reissue applications, make all rightful oaths and generally do everything possible to aid the said Company, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, to obtain and enforce proper patent protection for said improvements in all countries.
