ASSIGNMENT AND AGREEMENT

We hereby consent that a copy of this assignment shall be deemed a full legal and formal equivalent of any document which may be required in any country in proof of the right of the Joint Assignees to apply for patent or other form of protection for said inventions and to claim the aforesaid benefit of the right of priority.


We request that any and all patents for said inventions be jointly issued to the Joint Assignees in the United States, or to such nominees as they may jointly designate.

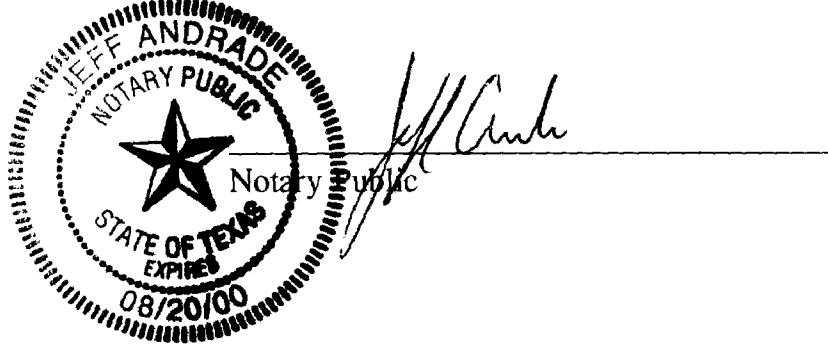

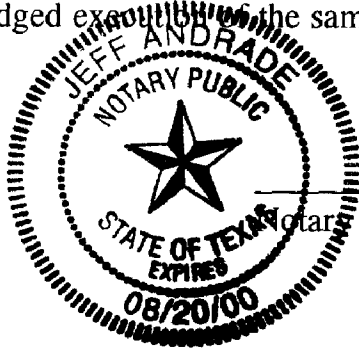
