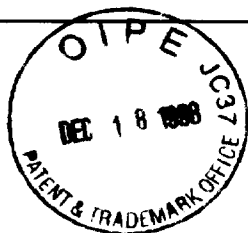

A S S I G N M E N T

Whereas I, the undersigned, **Arlen D.
